Our attorney has returned the Junk Vehicle Ordinance with our suggested fees and penalties incorporated. It was reviewed and Ziebell moved it's adoption. Dorshorst seconded. Motion carried. The ordinance will be added to the Code of Ordinances at 10-5-8.

Trustee Ziebell who is also Sec-Treas of the sanitary sewer system reported that an increase in sewer rates will be necessary by the end of the year.

Trustee Hartjes has inspected the welcomes signs on highway 13/34 and said the entire signs are in very poor condition and will need to be rebuilt. Various options to accomplish this will be looked at.

The listed bills were read and it was noted that we paid CAP Services their annual fee which they are supposed to take from the fund. The other bills were approved for payment.
