Meeting called to order by President Whipple at 6:00pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Trustee Reid moved to approve June minutes as typed, seconded by Trustee Steinle; carried unanimously.

Reading of the Bills by Treasurer Joanna Mack. Trustee Steinle made a motion to accept bills as typed, seconded by Trustee Larsen; carried unanimously.

Public Comments/Concerns:

- ★ Haas took that tree out by the park finally and we have the bill for that which is \$700.00.
- ★ United Ambulance report-average age on our calls was 53. In four years their contract is up and they are looking to extend it another 10.
- ★ The county pays Adams county to do their lines so they suggested we have Green Arrow do our curbs and lines. We will continue to follow up on this.
- ★ We did get a call from a resident that had a complaint about the road base being farther down from the blacktop near the mailbox-Tony will happily fill this with road base this week.

Old Business:

- Money Market-renewal update-We renewed 250,000 into a cd 3.71% we kept the MM 250,000 26,000 interest made for the money market splash pad funds for 3%. WE still don't have an answer from them on what we can do.

New Business:

- CMAR report-Resolution number SL-103a for the Compliance Maintenance Annual Report through the DNR concerning the sewage collection system for 2025, financial aspects and the sanitary sewer collection systems (operation & maintenance). Motion made to accept SL-103a CMAR by Trustee Steinle, seconded by Trustee Larsen; carried unanimously.
- Picnic license-Temporary Class B picnic gathering license for St. Philips church picnic on August 2nd. Motion made to approve by Trustee Steinle, seconded by Trustee Whipple; carried unanimously.
- Hillcrest & 3rd stop sign-the Sunset and Dairyland stop sign will now be a 4-way so that project will be completed first. Blonien & 3rd Stop sign-we will keep an eye on this for the summer and watch the traffic to see if we need to change this.

- Park-surge protector-Motion made for the Village to pay \$250(half the total) by Trustee Larsen for cleaning up the box and surge protector, seconded by Trustee Steinle; carried unanimously.
- Tennis courts are looking rough again with a big crack in it-a sports court over it would be nice to eventually put over but that is about \$25,000. Recreational CD fund is at \$35,687.94-we are able to use the interest accrued from this account to update the tennis courts. Trustee Steinle will keep her eyes open for a used surface for the tennis court. We will renew the \$25,000 for a CD and pull the interest out and put in a money market account. With this interest money we can have the fence fixed as well.
- August meeting @ fire station-August 11th, 6:00pm-due to the election this meeting will be held at the fire station.
